Sale of Church Properties	When congregations close and the property is sold the funds are to be sent to the District Office for the use of the wider church. Currently drawing \$15,000 per year from this fund for provision of repairs to District owned properties, ie Ferryden Park, Concordia Cemetery, Oakden, Ceduna etc.	\$351,319.10
Zinnbauer Fund	The fund was set up in 2003 following the sale of property at College Park that was owned by Pastor Zinnbauer and used as emergency housing. Interest from the fund for use by congregations for community mission projects. Average annual interest income of \$95,000. Three grants were provided in 2016 ranging in value from \$15,000 to \$25,000.	\$2,482,194.91
Mission Fund	The District is in receipt of an LLL Grant for mission projects. Grants up to \$5,000 are available to congregations for mission projects and can include training; purchase of resources and equipment. Eight grants were provided in 2016 ranging in value from \$570.00 to \$5,000.00.	\$117,969.18
Bequests	Various bequests have been received over a number of years with many not specifying a particular area of ministry.	\$1,050,214
Albert Geisler Deaf Ministry Fund	A bequest was received in 1997 from Mr Geisler who was a supporter of deaf ministry. Initially only interest was to be utilised to support deaf ministry. In 2016 DCC resolved that the fund's principal and interest could be used to support deaf ministry in the District.	\$165,511.74
Combined CFYYA/Events/CLW Funds	Total of 14 funds make up this total, ranging in value from approximately \$1,000 to over \$17,000. Events/camps that make a surplus have the funds deposited into their permanent fund. Camps are encouraged to use the funds for their camps, in special projects for children's ministry in their areas or to donate the funds to the CFYYA Department of the District.	\$80,965.36
Tatachilla Fund	The fund was set up in 2008 following the sale of a campsite; Synod resolved for the interest to be used for district wide camping ministry opportunities. Average annual interest income of \$36,000. Current annual use of the fund <i>(as approved by DCC December 2011)</i> : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$20,000 for camping coordinator position in District Office • \$15,000 for subsidies for training and resources for camping ministry and new camping initiatives • \$12,000 for subsidies of registration fees for camp leaders and participants. Fifteen payments were made to camps/people during 2016.	\$1,185,052.55
Taperoo Fund	To be used by Semaphore parish following sale of Taperoo church in 2012 for local mission projects. DCC agreed that these funds were to be used within 10 years of the property sale.	\$300,000.00

Chaplaincy Fund	Historically funds from Tertiary Ministries Support, Prisons Chaplaincy and other donations. The fund is utilised for professional development of chaplains, promotions, tertiary chaplaincy programs and other areas of chaplaincy support.	\$57,364.49
AbMinSA Funds	Information based on CAMSA 1997 – Principal is never to be spent, but interest is to be used for the ongoing ministry of AbMinSA through the payment of salaries, training, travel and other expenses. Interest from these accounts is returned directly to the District budget, AbMinSA Department to offset salaries.	\$498,961.58
LLL 40 th Anniversary Gift Fund	In December 2010, the LLL gifted funds to the District. Additional funds were received in more recent years for use in reconciliation training for pastors and lay workers. The District is currently utilising approximately \$12,000 per year for the support of graduate pastors and teaching ministry.	\$174,368.11
NSW Gift Money	In 2016 the NSW District gifted funds to the SA-NT District to use in any area of mission.	\$357,969.95
